Hanging Hardware Setup

Important things to consider

How long is the hanging gate, door etc. going to be?

The hanging channel is supplied in 2.9m or 5.8m lengths. Depending on your application, additional lengths will be needed. In this case, a joint support bracket would be required.

Will the channel be mounted on a wall or roof?

The channel bracket you need will vary depending on your application. For installation you will require at least 2x channel brackets per 2.9m length of gate track.

What type of rollers do you need?

Depending on the weight of your gate the rollers you need will vary. The 2 wheel rollers are suitable for loads up to 350kg, and the 4 wheel rollers for loads up to 460kg (per roller set).

Floor Mount Bolt Down Door Guide GTR077

This bolt down bracket supports your door and provides smooth movement when being moved by Richmond's hanging rollers.


To use: fix a guide plate to the bottom of your door, this sits in the middle of the GTR077 quide as the door is moved open and closed. The guide plate can be either flat bar, or angle iron. 6mm thick.



Hanging Hardware Setup




Available in 3 sizes (35mm, 50mm, and 60mm wide) to accommodate large and higher capacity rollers and door/gate frames.





Hanging 2 Wheel Roller Set







To fasten the GTR077 to the ground, we recommend using:

For Concrete: 2x Countersunk concrete screw anchors, or traditional dynabolts M6 x 50mm

For Timber: 2x Countersunk timber screws M6 x 50mm
